# APPLYING TO COLLEGE

## **Key Terms**

OCAS: Ontario Colleges Application Services: clearinghouse for all Ontario College applications

Ontario Colleges: Ontario application site and search engine for Ontario colleges/programs

Transmission: electronic transfer of information (demographics, marks etc.) from TDSB data base to OCAS

# IMPORTANT DATES

## **Important Dates**

- > October 2022: Online applications for Ontario colleges become available
- > November 1 2022: Earliest Offer Date
- ➤ May 1, 2023: Deadline to confirm Offers of Admission
- ➤ June 2023: Tuition Deposit Due at the Colleges

# FEBRUARY 1, 2023: DEADLINE FOR EQUAL CONSIDERATION

## **How Do I Apply?**

### www.ontariocolleges.ca

- ✓ Don't need a PIN
- √ Can apply in early Oct.

#### **How Much Does It Cost?**

- √ \$110 non-refundable fee for 5 Ontario Colleges (max. of 3 program choices/college)
- √ Cannot apply to more than 5
- ✓ May have supplemental Program Fees

# Ontario College Admission Requirements

- **√OSSD**
- √ Grade 12 English (college or university level)
- ✓ Pre-requisite Courses (depending on programs)
- ✓ Additional Criteria

#### Ontario College Admission Requirements

#### **OSSD** (Ontario Secondary School Diploma)

- **√** 18 compulsory courses
- ✓ 12 elective courses
- ✓ Successful completion of OSSLT (Grade 10 Literacy Test)
- ✓ 20 Hours of Community Involvement (reduced hours only for this year)

#### **Additional Criteria**

**Supplementary forms (additional cost)** 

**Audition/Interview** 

**Portfolio** 

Note: Different universities will have different requirements and due dates for the same programs; students must check websites/ontariocolleges.ca/view-book for details and deadlines.

# Language/Math Requirements

✓ May be required to complete a language and/or math proficiency assessment provided by the college, depending on the program requirements

✓ Applicants will be contacted after application is registered for booking the assessment

- ➤ E.g. TD Canada Trust Scholarships for Community Leadership; Toyota Earth Day Scholarships; Canadian Hospitality Foundation Scholarships

#### **Financial Aid**

- ✓ Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP) <u>www.osap.gov.on.ca</u> (midend of June)
- ✓ Financial Aid offered by Colleges
- ✓ Bank Loans and Lines of Credit
- ✓ Part-time/summer work/campus job
- √ Family

#### **Financial Aid**

#### **Bursaries:**

- Visit financial aid office at your college in late August
- > Eligibility is based on financial need
- > Applicants must have applied for OSAP
- ➤ No need to pay it back
- > Every little bit counts

#### **Students with IEPs**

- Must self-identify at college during registration process (they won't know you have an IEP unless you tell them)
- Current psycho-education assessment will be required in order to be considered for accommodations (within last 3 years)
- > IEPs are only for EH
- ➤ Each college will have its own learning centre/own policies

### **Pre-Application Process**

## Research the Program and/or College that is right for you:

- Check out ontariocolleges.ca, college websites, liaison officers, view-books to learn more about colleges/programs
- Check out open houses/school tours (online)
- Consult your guidance counsellor
- Talk to your parent/guardian/caring adults
- Check your credit counselling summary to make sure everything is in order
- Go to ontariocolleges.ca to look at How To Apply videos and read FAQs

### **Pre-Application Process**

#### **How Do I Make a Decision?**

- Program vs. School
- > Be Realistic
- Have a Plan B and Plan C

#### **Last Minute Details**

- Graduation requirements
- > Specific Program requirements
- > Non-academic requirements and deadlines
