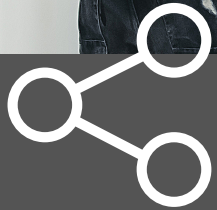

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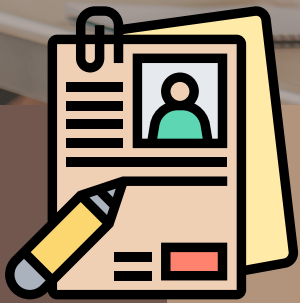

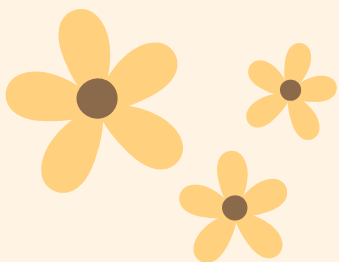

Youth in Care Tuition Bursary **NEW**

Open for Applications

Seneca, in partnership with the Child Welfare Political Action Committee, has launched a special bursary that will pay tuition for current or former youth in extended social care who are pursuing their first postsecondary credential. Thirty bursaries will be awarded starting in fall 2021 and continuing into winter 2022 and onwards.

Criteria to Apply:

- Prospective students must first apply to Seneca through [OntarioColleges](#) (OCAS) and receive an offer of admission before applying for the bursary.
- They must be pursuing their first postsecondary credential and apply to full-time studies.
- They must apply to the bursary before starting their studies.
- They must demonstrate financial need and submit an [OSAP](#) application every academic year.

Additional Benefits:

- Bursaries are renewable each academic year until graduation.

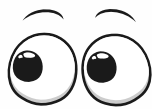
