

CAN STUDENTS TAKE COURSES IN BOTH SESSIONS?

Yes, students can enrol in a course in July and another course in August. However, after the challenges of the current school year, please give careful consideration to the impact of not having a break from school over the summer months. Be sure that devoting all of July and August to coursework is the best use of your summer time.

CAN & GRADE 8 STUDENTS ENTERING GRADE 7 IN 2021 TAKE & E-SUMMER COURSE?

Yes! We will be offering a Reach Ahead Credit GLD2OE- Exploring My Future Students will enhance their literacy and numeracy skills, increase their essential skills and personal development, be supported in their transition to secondary school and develop friendships through positive relationship building.

CAN STUDENTS TAKE BOTH AN E-SUMMER JULY & FACE-TO-FACE COURSE?

It is not recommended that students take more than one summer course in a month regardless of whether the course is face-to-face or online. It would mean 12-14 hours of coursework per day which does not give you enough time to do your best. If a student's Guidance Counsellor decides it is in the student's best interest to take both, e-Learning Central Office will not prevent them from enrolling, but strongly discourage the enrollment.

WILL THE E-SUMMER CREDIT COUNT TOWARDS THE MANDATORY ONLINE CREDIT?

Yes! e-Summer credits can count towards the 2 mandatory online credits that is a new requirement for students who began Grade 9 in September 2020 or later.




